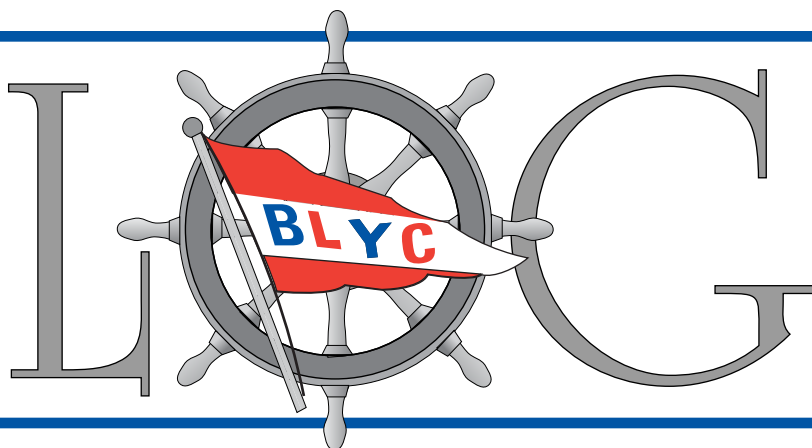

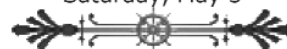

I would like to thank Sue Zeiher for making the beautiful BLYC wind sock; it looks so much better than the orange airport type socks we've flown in the past.

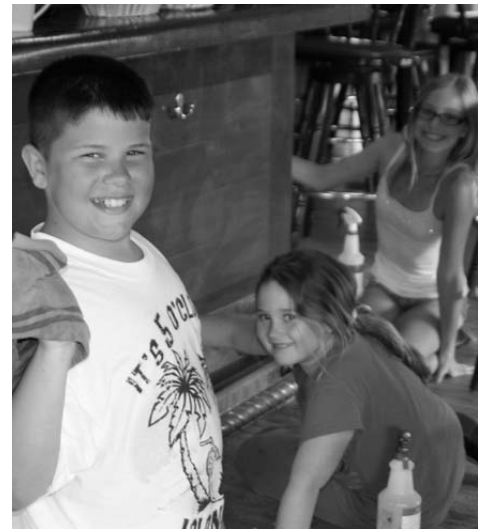
Also, a special thanks to Vic and Tami Schroeder who have graciously offered to fertilize/treat the grounds on Watkins island this year.

THE NEW DOCKS

New docks have appeared immediately east of our club. I interviewed Commodore Bob Zeiher to get our questions answered get this information out to you the members.

What got this started ?

Boat Boys managed by Tim Figgins (a BLYC member) sought to put new docks in front of their new location , formerly Sayre Bros. Marine. This is permitted by the State of Ohio not the yacht club.

What did Boat Boys propose ?

That Boat Boys build their docks then lease the new docks facing our club and in turn for the yacht club to lease the docks further east at area 8.

What was your role Commodore?

I was authorized by our board with the

other flag officers to negotiate with Boat Boys to represent our members interests. I did and further got board approval on the tentative agreement.

How do you know this is in our interest ?

We still own everything we originally owned. Chad McClannahan our member and attorney at no cost to us negotiated and wrote all agreements and leases for both par-

ties to assure our interests were protected.

We now have larger , newer docks closer to our club with separation distance from our current east side docks that exceeds state minimums and allow plenty of maneuver room for all boats.

Commodore , any final comments?

This is a true win-win , action needed to be taken quickly and much thanks to our board , Attorney and member Chad McClannahan and special thanks to Tim Figgins who has put power in and covered expenses to provide these new docks to us at no cost.

Thanks to you Commodore for your hard work and success in this important and beneficial project.

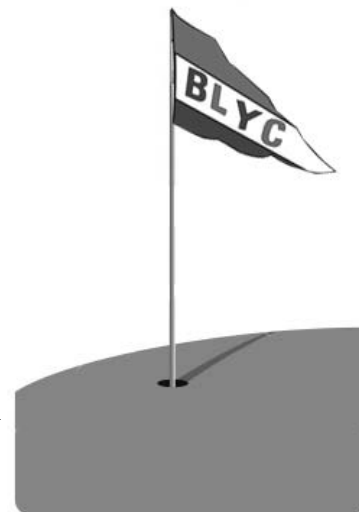

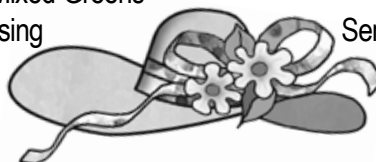

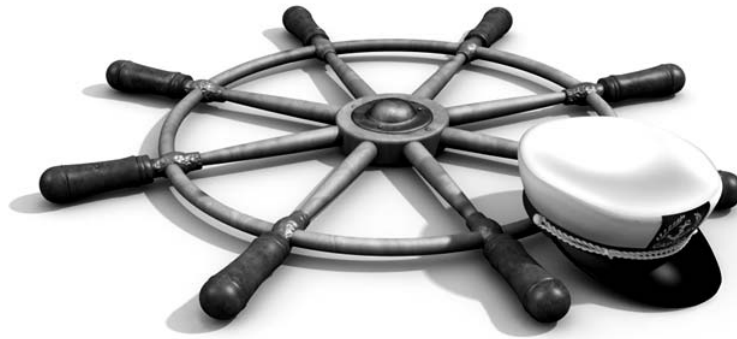
