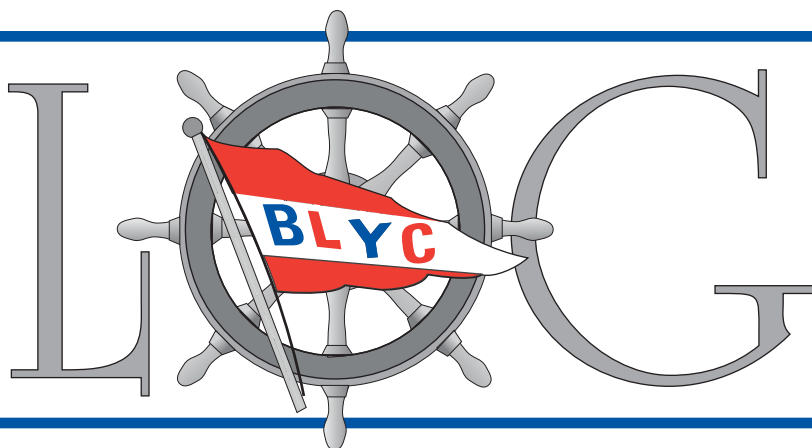

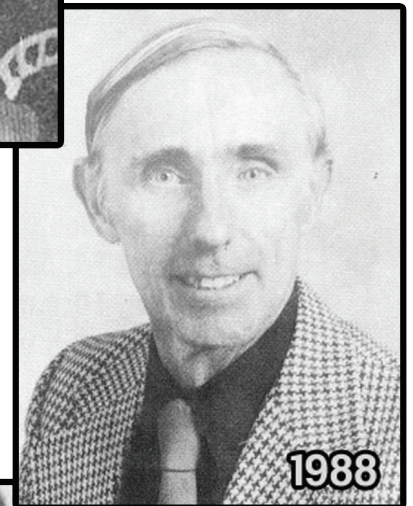


Looking Aft...
