

As I was perusing the old issues of the Log on the BLYC website looking for inspiration for a history article, I came across this, rather unique, picture published in May 1988. The picture, along with the accompanying text from then Club Historian P/C Frank Foster, III offers a timely lesson as we prepare to venture out on the lake this boating season. Safe Boating! -SGH

THE WAY WE WERE Commodore Frank H. Foster, Historian

A TYPICAL POWER BOATER. (I couldn't resist) We sailors love to say nasty things about power boaters regardless of whether or not we believe them. Many thanks to Bud Sayre who loaned the picture to me for publication in the Log and told me a bit about it. But first, a little quiz. Do you think you might know whose boat this is? WRONG! It's not Commodore Boehm, Don Hardy, or Ed Levison, so right away I have eliminated the obvious 99% of your guesses.

However, in 1961, this poor fellow, who was not a yacht club member, had overindulged in alcoholic beverages and went for a boat ride on Buckeye Lake at what must have been a high rate of speed. Suddenly, as you can see, he was no longer travelling at a high rate of speed but instead was impaled on two large steel beams being used to construct docks. Bud reports that there were two occupants and they were sitting on top of the back of the seats and therefore escaped being killed. AND NOW, THE REST OF THE STORY. As surprising as all of these events were, there is yet a more amazing part. Believe it or not this boat was repaired by Sayre's Marina and continued to be used on Buckeye Lake for at least another 10 years.

Docks & Rentals

By the time this edition of The Log hits the newsstands, some boats will already be in the water, mine included. Although Memorial Day is often recognized as the official start of summer, April is considered the unofficial start of boating season. April will have its cold days, but typically there are more "boatable" days than not. 80 degree days are not uncommon so you may want to extend your season a month or two by getting on the lake this month.

Some considerations to keep in mind as we get started enjoying this magnificent feeling of being in a vessel on the water. First off, the Club still has slips to rent in all areas at some of the best prices on the lake. If you want to rent a slip (or a garage or space in Eastport storage yard), go online to the Club website and fill out a request form. Those of you who don't "compute" can get a request form at the Club.

If you already have a dock with the club, you might want to check out your slip to see if the winter was kind to you. We have already started to make necessary repairs on some of the slips and evaluating others. If you have any problems, please contact me online or by phone. My cell number is: (614)975-1820, and my email is: captdave.lawrence@gmail.com.

If we can not get the repairs done in a timely manner, we will put you in another slip until yours is repaired.

Another important consideration is to commit by May 1, (paid in full), or the slip may become available to other club members. If we find out in the middle of the season you don't want your slip, it will be difficult to rent it.

Also, as we get started we need to remind renters to lock the gates each time you enter or leave the locked areas to reduce the chances of theft. Next, we absolutely need a signed copy of the "Dock Rental Agreement" before you put your boat in the slip. Speaking of which, remember it is State law that the boat in the slip MUST be titled to the renter.

Finally, make sure you have updated your personal information (phone #, email, and address) with the Club. Already this season I have not been able to contact certain members because of outdated information.

I am looking forward to a great boating season!
