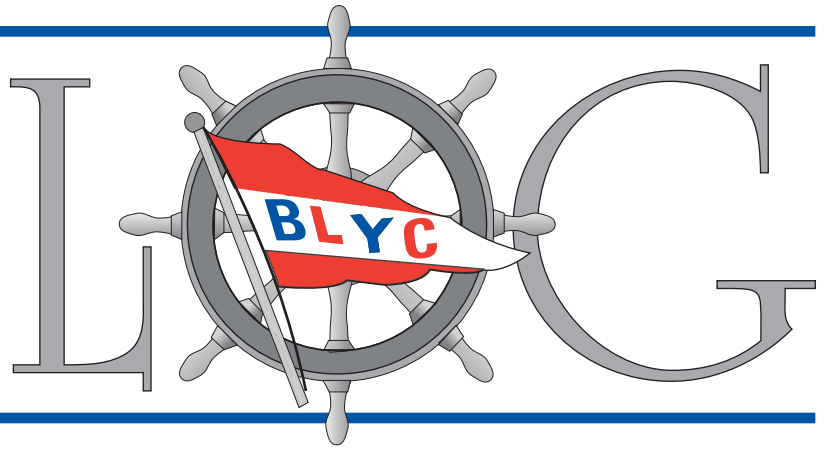

Docks & Rentals

It's summertime. Boats have been slower to get in the water this spring than I can remember in many years.

I do not have much to write for this month other than a few important reminders to share concerning Docks and Rentals. First of all, there are a number of slip renters who have not turned in their "Dock Rental Agreements. As stated previously, this is a contract that must be signed by all renters. Please read over these rules which come from Ohio Dept. of Natural Resources or Club By-laws. A number of renters have received a letter or phone call concerning violations.

Also, gates to the boat yard or to the slips are not constantly being locked when renters come and go. PLEASE, do this every time so as to protect property of others and our own. If you leave your vehicle in the boat yard while boating, the gates must still be locked behind you.

There is still an opportunity to slip into one of our slips as we still have docks to rent, as well as garages and storage space in the Eastport Yard. These all are good values and good locations. One can go online to the Club website to request a rental, or stop into the Club office for an application.

Finally, periodically stop by to check your riggings as high winds and big waves can sometimes loosen a knot that has been tied in a hurry or improperly. Several members have reported that they have had to tie up someone's boat to keep it from banging another's boat. Remember, you are legally responsible for such damage that could occur. If you are not sure how to tie a good marine knot, ask another boater or sailor.
