


I would like to go over a few items with everyone. First the pool heater has had some gas regulator problems. We believe it has to do with the gas line and the demand on the gas flow. Our gas supplier will be working with us on the problem this week. Also concerning the pool it appears that there may be a leak, as we add several hundred gallons of fresh water every morning, this also adds to the water temperature issue. Everyone is working on this issue.

We will get everyone two permits this week. Please keep in mind that everyone will receive two permits and the permits are designed to hang on your rear view mirror. 
