# JUNIOR SAILING

In the last four years we've gone from 2 to 4 to 6 to 9 Travelers Series Jr. Racers (6 at Bay Week). We've had as many as 62 in our camps; from as far away as Washington D.C., West Virginia, and Pennsylvania.

Our members have children and grandchildren and sometimes nieces and nephews who can benefit from our setting at BLYC and from all the talents of our membership. As I have said before, the Jr's can gain many experiences and learn many skills in categories such as responsibility and accountability, safety, social, planning and organizing, marketing, communications, flexibility/adapting...and have fun doing them.

To help ensure success we've filed for 501(c)(3) status (which means all donations are tax deductible) and we've got a "business plan" with 11 primary points: Race Coach, Instructors & Instruction; Race Team Equipment & Logistics; Camp Equipment; Racing Safety & Camp Power Boats; Security & Risk Management; Juniors' Room (upstairs at BLYC); Marketing; Fundraising; Financials; Youth Board & Other Youth Activities; and, Annual Schedule.

Each of these 11 points have a team with a Team Lead to achieve the goals within each point. This increases participation across our membership. We held a meeting with the membership (everyone received an invite; telephone, emails, "email blast", and The Log) to communicate what's going on.

The points cover items to ensure protection/maintenance of equipment, responsibility and accountability of the youth and adults, solid curriculum for our camps, purchasing of equipment (sail boats, safety boat, rigging and safety equipment), increased participation, and the raising of money to do all these things. If you'd like a copy of the plan just let me know.

We even set up sponsorship levels:

- 1. Regatta = \$2,000
- 2. Thistle = \$1,000 to \$2,000
- 3. 420 = \$500 to \$1,000
- 4. Laser = \$100 to \$500
- 5. Friends of BLYC Jr. Sailing = up to \$100

To date we have raised about \$8,000 with one in the Regatta levels, two in the thistle level, one in the 420 level and a few "Friends". And, we have quite a few who have committed we just have to confirm the levels. Please join in.

One finished project is the hardwood floors in the Club bar. Much of the finish under the chairs was worn off and dirty looking. The floor was stripped and refinished and looks marvelous! If you have not seen the flooring since it was finished, I invite you to check it out and see why we have received many compliments. This actually was made possible by the now defunct Gun Club. After many years and a great winter tradition of skeet shooting, the EPA shut down the the Gun Club because of the lead shot (even though the Club promised to use steel shot, which many were using anyway). When the club was disbanded, there were funds still in the treasury and President John Doneff, upon finding the need for funding of the floors, donated the money to accomplish this. Thanks, shooters! In our master plan, we are also looking to refinish the floors in the fireplace room.

We had the carpet cleaned in the dining room, hoping that if it were cleaned it would look good enough to last another year or so. However, like officiating football, "after further review, the ruling on the previous play has been overturned." Some stains did not come out and the seams are frayed, so we decided that we will replace the carpet. By the time you read this Log, we will have the third estimate and, hopefully, definite plans to finish installation before the holidays. We also have three bids for a new pool heater, three bids for a new ice machine in the kitchen and three bids for the cupola (the "light house" on top of the club.) We also have some bids for insulating beneath the club and fixing the back steps. This may not sound very exciting to some, but the thought of one of the most storied clubs in a several state area getting the attention that it so deserves motivates me to continue working hard to accomplish this. As always, suggestions continue to be welcomed.
