### HOUSE & GROUNDS



### DOCKS & RENTALS

Hello all.

As I stated in last month's Log, I put together a new dock policy to give present dock renters options concerning your rental this season and for our members, who are not present dock renters, but wish to rent this season. This policy is a result of many suggestions from our dock renters. Thank you for your input!

The 2015 Dock Rental Policy has been approved at the last Board Meeting. If you are a present dock renter or member wishing to rent a dock this season, please familiarize yourself with this policy.

### 2015 Boating Season Dock Rental Policy

### Terminology:

*Present dock renters*: Members who were billed 2015 dock rent with their membership dues

*New dock renters:* Members who wish to rent a dock for the 2015 season and did not rent during the 2014 season

*\$45.00 Retention fee:* The fee paid to continue "rental rights" to your numbered dock

- All Present dock renters shall be refunded the "State Dock Permit" fee. No New dock renter shall be accessed the "State Dock Permit"
- ★ All Present dock renters who have paid their dock rental fees and are unable to use their dock due to low water levels shall request a full refund of dock fees paid.
- ★ All Present dock renters who request a full refund because of non dock use - for a \$45.00 retention fee, they may retain the right to their same numbered dock for the 2016 Boating Season
- ★ All Present dock renters, who choose to pay the \$45.00 retention fee, will permit BLYC TO RENT their dock to a New dock renter for the 2015 Boating Season

"Mac" McVey Junior Training Governor and have a lift in their dock, shall be permitted to keep their lift in place. BLYC Dock Governor shall insure caution tape be put across the dock entrance for safety purposes. Lifts must be raised above water level to be visible. Docks with lifts shall be considered "nonrentable"

- ★ New dock renters may request a dock rental at any time during the 2015 Boating Season. Cost shall be the normal dock rental fee, minus the State Dock Permit.
- ★ New dock renters, who request to rent a Present dock renter's dock shall be made aware the dock use will be for the 2015 Boating Season only and no lift will be permitted.
- ★ Present dock renters and New dock renters may request a full refund of rental fees no later than July 1, 2015.
- ★ Present dock renters who do not request a full refund, it shall be assumed you are using your dock.
- ★ The \$45.00 retention fee will be placed in a separate fund to be used for dock issues, as needed.

The Dock Governor and BLYC business office shall work together to insure this policy is correctly followed. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Finally, if you are storing something in our Eastport Storage Yard, it's imperative that you are in your correct numbered spot. I'm receiving many requests for storage spots, at times I assign a spot only to find someone in the "unassigned" numbered spot. Please tag your property with a name and again, insure you are in your assigned numbered spot.
