As September arrives, most of us turn our attention to fall and, certainly in central Ohio, football and OH...IO! September in Ohio typically has some of the best weather of all the months - pleasant days and cool nights! These are good days to spend some time at the Club! In fact, our goal is to keep the pool open through most of September, weather permitting. With the new heater, the cool nights won't affect the water temperature much at all. Unfortunately, this past month we had a bout with two different types of algae at the same time, which closed our pool for a week. Allow me to explain our pool procedures for those of you who may not be aware of them. First, and foremost, we use a professional pool service for all of our pool needs. We use K&K Pool and Spa Solutions, a local company on Route 79. They open the pool in the spring and close it in the fall. We have worked with them for years. They have digital testing equipment with which they test our water samples for free and generate an action plan for treatment when needed. We have never had a problem with this company. The pool is tested daily for chlorine levels and pH, among other things. We have an automatic chlorine dispensing system which reduces the chances of human error. We realize that some members were inconvenienced by the closure, particularly daily lap swimmers. For that, we apologize. We opened back up as soon as the testing showed the water to be safe. Water purity and the health & safety of our members will always be the number one priority that we consider when deciding when to resume swimming activity. So, on some of the beautiful fall days ahead, come on out and enjoy our pool!

This will be my last *Log* article as head of House and Grounds. I hope that you have enjoyed the appearance of our beautiful Club under my watch. I have tried to put the "best face" on the old Gal! I did have many volunteers who have helped to make all this possible and have given thanks in previous *Log* articles. Don't forget that next month is Fall clean-up time - usually late October - and make a commitment to come out and help in this important endeavor.
