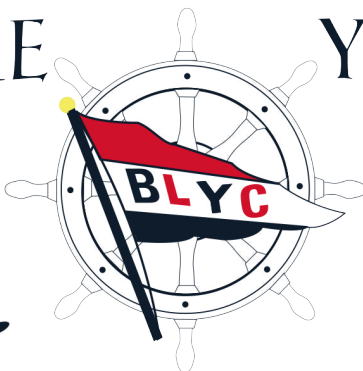

## BAR & KITCHEN

**Bon Appetite!** I hope that you are starting to notice some changes in our bar and dining room service, menu, and specials. Please bear with us as we strive to improve on all aspects of the total dining experience. I ask for patience because this not an "overnight" fix. However, some changes should be immediately noticed. We are going to provide ongoing training to all B&K employees including servers, bartenders, kitchen staff, supervisors, and myself! One of my best friends, with whom Laura and I went to the National Championship Game, is Vice President of Ignite Restaurants (Joe's Crab Shack and others) and has agreed to tutor me in restaurant management.

One of our changes has been in the dessert area, where we are making an effort to have most of our desserts made in-house. So far, we have had an overwhelming positive response to a delicious variety of desserts including individual pumpkin pies, pecan pie tarts, fall apple rose, blueberry cobbler and apple crisp — both with a scoop of Weldon's ice cream. Baking desserts is our own Lisa Brownlee who is taking classes to be a pastry chef. You will hear more about Lisa in a future issue of the *Log* as we are going to feature a B&K employee each month. Come out and try one of Lisa's pastries and you will see what all the buzz is about! Who knew the Club would become a "pâtisserie?" Another change is in the staff's attire. We want to project a more professional image in line with a fine private club such as BLYC, so we have a new look for our bartenders. Also, Larry Enmen, our House Manager, is sporting a new look as well.

### B&K Motto

We are aware that we can do better, and that is not to say things necessarily have been bad. In fact, our motto for B&K employees is: "Be Great!" Good is not good enough for our Club — and "great" must be constant and not just when our employees feel like it. This is our expectation for our staff and we cannot — and will not — accept anything less!

## Featured Employee

Our first featured B&K employee is Chef Josh Daniels. He is a 16 year veteran of the food business. His introduction was as a butcher for the first 2 years, an experience that provided a wealth of knowledge in choosing fine cuts of meat. He then moved into the restaurant side of the business in some well known and respected eateries. He worked as a cook at the Refectory in Dublin, then moved to the same position at the Medallion Country Club. He then became chef at the Buxton Inn in Granville for a couple of stays and settled as assistant to Chef Matt, where he was known as the man behind the great soups over the years. After Chef Matt left, Josh ascended to the level of Chef at BLYC. He is a certified restaurant sanitation specialist and has taken culinary courses at Columbus State. He is extremely talented and we are fortunate to have him.

Finally, we have developed new Happy Hour prices — Wednesday through Friday from 4:00 to 7:00 — in an attempt to be more competitive with other establishments. Cans of beer and drafts are \$1.50, bottles are \$2.50, well drinks \$3.50, top shelf \$2 off, wine 50 cents off per glass, and \$1 off per bottle. Wings are 50 cents (dine in only) and other appetizer specials will follow. Come in and unwind with friends at the Club and take advantage of these great prices.

If you are interested in being on the B&K committee, please let me know. We want to have 5-6 members to serve as a steering committee and serve as a resource group. Experience in the food business is a plus, but not a prerequisite.
