Ahoy shipmates!

Your 2015 "Adventure in Paradise" continues. Your BLYC staff has worked hard to set you on the road to Paradise — better service, a new look, more food selections, homemade desserts, and much better happy hour drink pricing. We have a lot of wonderful events planned for December so I invite you to come to your Club and take part in this great adventure! You will see some changes taking place.

You will see some changes taking place. We have removed the front gates in preparation for the safety fence that will be installed along the length of the dam. We continue to meet with the ODNR and they assure us the BLYC will have continuous access to our Club throughout this process. We will be losing the three covered docks alongside the entrance bridge and eventually, the bridge will come out when the "berm" is installed. We have been told that there will be a "manned" gate at our bridge to allow our personnel and members access to the Club whenever we are open.

In order to secure our long term financial success, we have established a new Finance Committee. The Finance Committee is chaired by Governor Mark Pyle and the other members are; the Commodore, P/C Gayle Fisher-Mulvey, Governor Don Dick, and Governor Mike McVey. Mark Pyle was also elected Club Treasurer at the last Governors' meeting. The Finance Committee will provide continuity in the budgeting process and assist the Board and Trustees in both short- and long-term financial planning. As I am sure you are aware, there will be extra expense to the Club as a result of the construction of the new dam. We have been accruing "Capital Improvement" funds to help deal with this extra expense. At the request of our Finance Committee, the Club needs to increase the amount of money going towards capital improvement. We have recently voted to increase the yearly capital improvement contribution from \$100/year to \$125/ year, so you will see a \$25 increase in your yearly dues with this money going solely to capital improvement to help develop reserves to deal with the extra expense surrounding our connection to the mainland, including the bridge and our utilities. It is important to note that as long as membership remains strong, there is no plan to make an "assessment" to members for this expense.

Concerning membership, RC McEntire is doing a terrific job and I encourage all members to work with her to attract people to the Club. As always, the best thing that members can do to help maintain our traditions is to renew your membership in January, encourage your friends and neighbors to join the Club, and to come out and enjoy the adventure your staff and officers have provided. The dam may be under construction, but the view from the island is magnificent!

We in B&K are still looking at ways to improve the dining experience and have enjoyed a lot of positive feedback for increased variety of choices, new specials, and great desserts. One of the problems that we are experiencing in trying to provide a great evening and meal is the lack of members making reservations. We always plan for a few extra walk-ins and have extra food prepared. However, when that many more than expected show up, it is difficult to operate smoothly. In an attempt to run an efficient kitchen, we order food and schedule servers based on reservations. With the trying times of the dam repair, we can not afford to have a lot of food left over and to pay servers who have no tables to wait on. An inordinate amount of waste is the downfall of many food service establishments — so we just can't prepare meals for 80 to 100 people in case they show up. Sometimes the thinking is "it won't be very busy so we don't need a reservation." Please, please, please help us do a better job by making reservations every time you are coming to the Club.
