The State of Ohio recently passed legislation to assist those businesses impacted by the decision to lower lake levels and repair the dam. The Lakes in Economic Distress Grant and Loan programs were rolled out on April 12, 2016. The applications are being processed on a first-come, first-served basis by the Ohio Development Services Agency. The Club applied for both the \$10,000 grant and the up to \$20,000 interest free loan on April 12<sup>th</sup>. We received confirmation that the applications were received and will be working with the State to complete the process. In the meantime we are working on revising the budget to guide us for the remainder of the year, now that we have the results of the annual membership billing process. Financial results of the first six months will be presented at the Semi-Annual Meeting May 1<sup>st</sup>.
