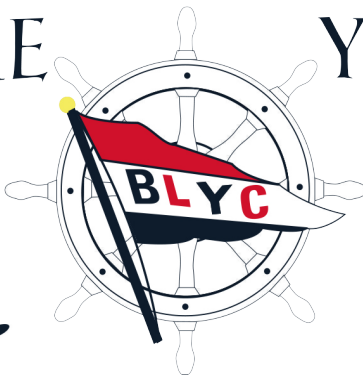

Ahoy shipmates!

The lake may still be low, but the swimming pool is "Full Pool." We are gearing up for a great summer season as your *Adventure in Paradise* continues poolside. We will be providing extra service and food selections at the pool. We will also have happy hour pricing Wednesday – Friday. Don't worry about the water temperature, we have installed a new pool heater and, as for facilities, we have refinished the downstairs bathrooms and showers. So, come on out and enjoy the fun where the water is always just right.

DAM UPDATE: We continue to work closely with the ODNR to maintain a safe entrance and keep the Club open. Phase 1, the berm and 40' deep seepage barrier is complete. We expect the gates to the spillway will be closed in the beginning of June allowing the lake to fill to an, as yet, undetermined level. Phase 2 is still not released, has not gone out to bid, and/or a contract awarded. I have been told by people at the ODNR it could be another 5 months before a contract is let. So, we should have an uninterrupted summer at our bridge. We have a lot of open items we are working on with the ODNR to try and get our members access to the water, once there is water in the

lake. We have no new items to report yet, but we will keep you posted as things develop. We want to give a special thanks to the ODNR and their prime contractor, ASI, for keeping us open during the installation of the berm and seepage barrier.

BULLETIN: You will notice our new sewage macerator system is complete and the concrete repaired out back. Also, at the Club's request, ODNR/ASI has opened the back of the Club so there will be a flow of water when the lake level rises and has installed a new, temporary bridge to provide better access for our members. You will also notice our utility lines have been buried and covered with earth to prevent freezing in the winter.

MEMBER BENEFIT: One of the benefits of belonging to an I-LYA Yacht Club is reciprocal privileges. We have formal invitations from the Sandusky, Grosse Ile, Cleveland, Harbor Bay, and Buffalo Yacht Clubs, but there are also Yacht Clubs all over the U.S. that you can enjoy. Check with Rebecca for a list of reciprocal Clubs, and don't fail to take advantage of this important privilege.

In conclusion, your *Adventure in Paradise* continues. The team working on the upstairs history lounge has made tremendous progress. A big thanks to Steve Harris, Bruce Ames, Don Harris, Dave Lawrence, Don Dick, John Albrecht, Chuck Gleich, Linda Masone, Jeff Gutridge, Barb Hein, Evan Bruckelmeyer, Mike & Shelly Higgins, Mike Smith, Lisa Stewart, Dave Todd and all that have donated time, energy, and money to make this new expansion of the Club a reality. This has been wasted space for a very long time, but now it will become a new, useable area of the Club for members to enjoy. 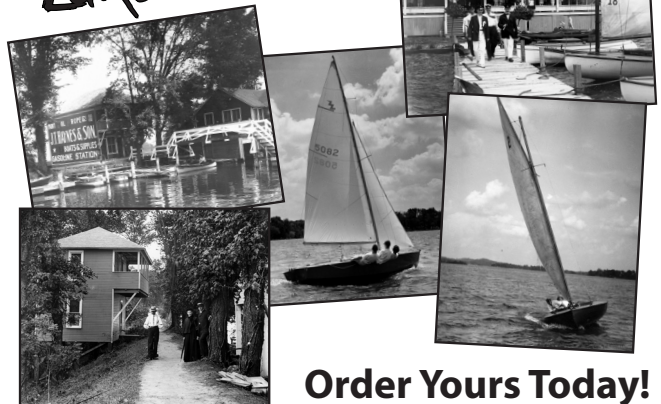

COMMUNICATIONS & FINANCE

- Governor Mark Pyle

Summer is upon us and so are the summer hours at the Club along with Happy Hour times and prices extended to the poolside grill! Make sure to read your *Log*, check out the web site, check in on our Facebook page or follow BLYC on Twitter to get news of upcoming events.

During the month of May, the Finance Committee continued working with the State of Ohio on processing the Economic Distress Grant (\$10,000) and Loan (\$20,000) applications.

We also applied with the Small Business Association for the economic disaster loan under the Below Average Water Levels of Buckeye Lake program. We continue to supply SBA with information to support the application. We are pursuing the loans to give us options to choose the most advantageous borrowing terms, should we need additional funds.

In addition we will be working through the results of the energy audit conducted by a contractor recommended by AEP Ohio through its Business Energy Savings program. The company was contacted to perform a no-cost energy assessment for the Club and grounds. The study will assist us with a cost/benefit analysis aimed at targeted improvements that result in savings on our utility bills.

LOOKING AFT

BLYC's Benefactor

Through the years, countless men and women have worked to make BLYC the great Club that it is. One, in particular however, stands out – Edgar Thurston Wolfe – Commodore of BLYC in 1934 and of the Inter-Lake Yachting Association in 1937.

Known to most as a newspaper man, publisher of the *Ohio State Journal* and the *Columbus Dispatch*, his interests and activities went well beyond his successes in business. As his obituary read, “The dominant motivation of Edgar Thurston Wolfe was the civic improvement of this community.” He was influential in many improvements in the Columbus area – the establishment of Port Columbus, improved hospital service, better school buildings, and development of the expressway system.

Born in 1893, the son of Robert F. Wolfe, he was a graduate of Princeton University and an accomplished musician. Shortly before graduation in 1917 and just days after the U.S. entry into World War I, Edgar enlisted in the Navy and served until war's end. It was said that he gained his appreciation for the water and love of boating as a result of this service. He maintained several boats here at Buckeye Lake, on the Florida coast, and on Lake Erie.

His influence and generosity extended beyond the city of Columbus,

however. Summering on Journal Island, Wolfe was an active member of BLYC with a great love for the lake. In addition to championing improvements at and around Buckeye Lake, he is also remembered for marshalling the resources of the Club, in January of 1937, to assist flood victims in Portsmouth. Under his leadership, the Club sent 11 boats and dozens of members by train to assist in the rescue efforts and distribute food and clean water to the victims. Photos from this flotilla hang in the entryway of the Clubhouse.

Less known, and significant to the life of the Club, is that he may be the reason that BLYC survived the Great Depression. When it came time for BLYC to buy out the remaining shares of the Building Company, formed to purchase the island initially, the Club didn't have the resources to cover it. Always generous when the Club was in need, Commodore Wolfe purchased the remaining shares. Annually, for several years through the 1930's, Commodore Wolfe would meet with the current Commodore in front of the fireplace in the Clubhouse, discuss how the Club was faring, and place some of those shares into the fire. Thanks to his generosity, the final shares were burned on November 28, 1938 and BLYC owned our home outright.

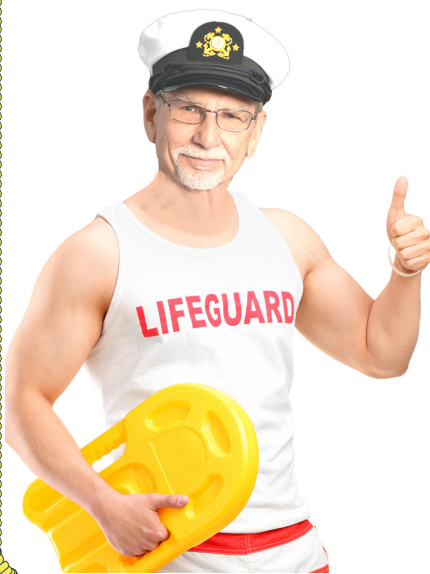
