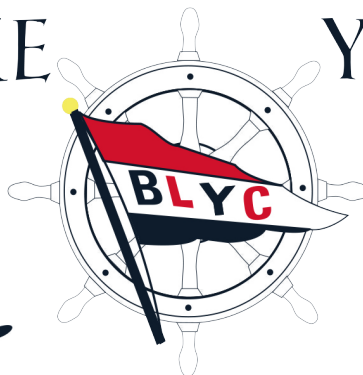

#### Ahoy shipmates!

If you haven't been over to our boatyard at Eastport lately, you need to stop by and have a look at the new 40 ton, 88' sternwheeler, the *Queen of the Lake III*. This boat, originally called the *Elizabeth Anne*, was donated to the Buckeye Lake Historical Society by Dr. Ron & Cindy Downing, who have applied for membership in our Club. The Downings had configured the boat as a houseboat on the Muskingum River, but the Historical Society will convert it to an excursion boat in the style of the earlier Queens that plied the waters of Buckeye Lake. The Yacht Club has agreed to house the vessel in our boatyard until its launch in 2018. This vessel will make our beautiful lake accessible to thousands of people over the years. The Society is looking for contributions to help with this conversion. Stop by the museum and give them a hand.

**DAM UPDATE:** Phase 1, the berm, is complete and the contractors have left the area except for a skeleton crew. They have committed to keeping our entrance open, accessible and safe throughout this period. Construction is not expected to begin until next spring. The outlet gates have been closed and they are allowing

the lake to fill to a level that is 2' above winter pool. This is also considered to be 1' below summer pool. Of course, they can't put water in the Lake, so, if you know any rain dances, now is the time. We are working with the State to try and make our docks accessible once there is water in the Lake. We don't have any definitive answers yet, but we will keep you informed the minute we know something.

**BULLETIN:** I have just been advised that power has once again been connected through the dam to our docks at Eastport. This means we will be able to run bubblers this winter and protect these docks. We have also asked the ODNR to allow us to connect at least one of the two Eastport docks to the mainland and we would join them together so our members could get access to these docks next year. I don't expect them to approve this — we can only hope.

**PARKING LOT:** We continue to have cars parked in our lot that are not identified with a Club parking permit. We have begun placing warning notes on the windshield. If you have received a note, please take steps to get a permit in your car and up-to-date. If you have guests coming that do not have a permit, they can obtain a permit from the bar. We will continue for at least another month to put warning notes on vehicles, but we will eventually take action, so, please get your permits in place.

Your *Adventure in Paradise* continues. The pool has been a wonderful place to relax and enjoy your Club and our beautiful lake. We have new adventurous signage, chair-side service, and a much larger pool menu. This month we will begin weekly "parasol" style drink specials. Pina Colada anyone? Please come to the Club and enjoy the ambiance, food, service, and escape that only your Yacht Club can provide.

The arrival of a new tour boat for the lake occurred June 15. It is being stored in the boat yard until renovations are completed and the lake is useable. The intent from the Museum is to launch it in 2018, per the Museum Director.

All of the club's accessible docks, those attached to the island, are spoken for and have extensive waiting lists. The waiting lists are posted on the porch. The other docks the club rents have been disconnected from the main land as a part of the dam remediation. As such, they are not currently useable.

The board is still working on a plan to access the docks not attached to Watkins Island. I have no open spaces in area 300 but we do have several in area 200 if you are interested in reserving one.

We have 3 garages available for rental and 20 open spaces in the Eastport Boatyard.

**Happy Birthday USA!** We are getting into the meat of summer and a great time to enjoy your Yacht Club! As the days heat up, we have seen a substantial increase in members coming to dine at the Club. Of course, we are very excited about that. However, it has led to some problems — many stemming from the failure of some of our members to make reservations. Last Friday was a good example. We had reservations for 54 guests and had 120 show up! An almost identical situation occurred the week before. Additionally, most of our members/guests arrived around 7:00 pm. I have noticed over the years that 7:00 is the most common time for our members to dine — myself included. Our staff anticipates "walk-ins" based on previous history and prepares for 30 additional guests. However, when 70 additional diners show up, it usually has negative consequences such as long wait times and slower service. We are going to start giving priority service to members who have made reservations. If someone shows up at, let's say, 7:00, they will be told they we can seat you now, but it may be 45 minutes to an hour before you will be served. Remember, not only do we have members with reservations at 7:00, but more at 7:15, 7:30, and so on. Last week, some members who had reservations waited over an hour to an hour and a half to eat their meal. This was not fair to those individuals who were responsible and made a reservation. Whatever the situation, please be patient and not lose your temper or get angry with the staff. In an attempt to lessen serving time, we also will have a special menu that eliminates dishes that are time consuming to prepare when we have special entertainment or expect a large crowd.

Dinner with a million dollar view is very popular in the summer, so I encourage members to expect some wait time — particularly those who did not make reservations. Sit and relax, listen to the music, have a cocktail, talk with friends and simply enjoy the experience of dinner on the water! Remember... it's summertime, and the living is easy!

The influx of new members this fiscal year has been exciting as we welcome the new members and has been a great help in mitigating the loss of revenue from spring and summer boating traffic and dock rentals.

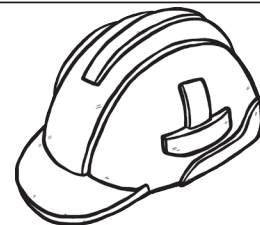
