# FINANCE COMMITTEE

At the September 22, 2019 Annual Meeting we will be calling a vote to change the BLYC CONSTITUTION, ARTICLE VIII. MEETINGS, Section 3.

#### Currently the BLYC Constitution reads:

#### Section 3

Twenty percent (20%) of the eligible voting members in good standing shall constitute the required quorum at any Regular or Special Meeting, and a simple majority shall determine the issue(s) involved, unless otherwise provided.

As mentioned in previous articles, we need well over 100 members eligible to vote to attend any Regular or Special meeting to approve any change in the BLYC Constitution, as well as this proposed amendment. I've attended many meetings since joining the Club in 2006 and attendance has never come close to the required number to cast a vote. There are many areas in the BLYC Constitution that need updated and voted upon. However, we've chosen to focus only one simple modification to address the reality of our historic meeting attendance. With this change we will be able to propose and vote on changes at any Regular or Special meeting with the prospect of change taking place.

### The proposed amendment is as follows:

#### Section 3

**Ten percent (10%)** of the eligible voting members in good standing shall constitute the required quorum at any Regular or Special Meeting, and a simple majority shall determine the issue(s) involved, unless otherwise provided.

We are in the process of drafting an official amendment document and obtaining the necessary signatures from twentyfive eligible and voting members in good standing as required by Article IX Amendment of Constitution, Section 1. Once that step is complete the proposed amendment will be posted on the official bulletin board in the bar area at least 30 days before the Annual Meeting, as well as published in the *Log* again in September in accordance with the rules for amendment.

This simple reduction from twenty percent to ten percent to define a quorum will be more in line with our members' historic interest in the governance matters of the Club. With this modification, we can then bring about needed changes to the Constitution in line with modern day gender terminology and anti-discrimination and equal opportunity language. One thing to note is that this proposed change retains all of the advance notification requirements for future changes and it still allows all members to attend a meeting and vote.
