The House and Grounds staff, along with our fellow BLYC employees, work hard to ensure your safety and enjoyment while at the club. Every day, starting early in the morning, the staff cleans and sanitizes all bathrooms, cleans and checks the chemical levels for our pool, keeps hand sanitizer dispensers full throughout the club, and assists other areas in providing excellent service to our members, and their guests and families.

With that, House and Grounds has been busy:

The parking lot is now finished — repaired, sealed, and new lines painted. Please observe the "No Parking" areas and display your blue BLYC 2020 parking sticker. We now have over 570 members and limited parking spaces. Parking stickers are for the member and spouse or significant other. The exception is if a member of your family is living with the actual member. Then another parking sticker can be requested. If you have guests with you or coming later, please go to the bar and get a visitor pass. It will be dated for the day of the visit and must be displayed in the guest's front windshield.

We have put up a sunscreen at the pool. Although it only provides shade in a limited area, it is the best we can do for now. Sadly, we have found beer bottles in the pool area during morning clean-up — Sorry no glass within the pool area fence and please observe the posted hours. The health department checks our pool regularly and we have an excellent record for cleanliness and chemical balance.

Our pool rules seem to be ever changing as the Health Department changes restrictions and what is permitted. Please continue to watch our posted rules and information in the weekly e-News. They are kept up-to-date. Please remember, the guiding principles for these rules is your safety. Your cooperation is appreciated.

The locks on the dock entry and club entrance gates have caused us some problems. We are working to remedy the issues. If the doors are shut and the locking device is in place, please do not leave the door open. If the doors are propped open, do not remove the device keeping it open. We will be installing new locks which should solve the problem.

Due to storm damage, we will be replacing the shingles, and the underlayment as necessary, on the Clubhouse. This project will start as soon as the pool closes for the off-season. As of this writing, the Army Corps of Engineers are still considering our application. We have been asked by the Ohio Historical Society to provide information concerning our project as well. This, too, has now delayed our start.

A new staircase is being built from the porch to the pool. NO food or drink can be brought from another venue or home to be used within the club. If you have a boat docked around the club you are permitted to take it directly to your boat.

Pets – The only animals allowed on club grounds are those properly trained and defined as "assistance animals" by the Ohio Revised Code — seeing eye dogs, for example. NO "service" dogs or good 'ole pets. Again, if taking your pet to your boat — yes they can cross our property just have them on a leash.

Thank you for your cooperation. It is appreciated.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

It's hard to believe that we are ten months into the fiscal year with our two busiest months ahead. With the receipt of the Paycheck Protection Program ("PPP") loan, generous contributions from members to our Coronavirus Employee Relief Fund ("CERF") fund, and the member support we received during the curbside carryout period, the Club remains on solid financial footing. Due to delayed government approvals we've not been able to begin some of our more expensive, yet necessary, seawall replacement projects. However, that delay has allowed us to remain in a strong cash position until we were permitted to fully open the Club under social distancing rules.

As for the PPP funding of \$99,800, with the recent changes to the program in Congress, it is a safe assumption that most, if not all, of the loan will be forgiven. With the skillful coordination of the Auxiliary, we are still moving forward on hosting a fundraising event on August 1st. With that, we have identified several projects we plan to undertake over the next 18 months and will be looking for assistance in funding.

The following projects have been identified:

- Replace stairs to pool,
- Reconfigure and replace entertainment tent and add surrounds,
- Island landscaping (after sea wall completion),
- Parking lot entry design and landscaping, including gate(s),
- Lights and sea gull prevention for docks,
- Sound system enhancements for better island coverage,
- Phone system upgrade to improve functionality,
- Pool bar area remodel, including repairing house skirting behind bar,
- Additional security cameras to improve coverage in external dark spots,
- Tables and chairs for events to replace damaged or deteriorating furniture,
- Umbrellas for the pool and patio.

As a reminder, in Ohio, anyone born after January 1, 1982 is required by law to pass a boating safety course to operate a boat. It's a good idea for everyone! There are a number of free online courses available and BLYC Junior Sailing hosts an ODNR safe boating course at the Club each winter. I think that promoting safe boating is in the interest, if not a part of the mission, of BLYC and BLYC members. Together, let's set the example of safe, responsible, and FUN boating for the greater lake community.


