Elections are over — Congratulations to those who gained a governorship and thanks to all who ran.

A big thank you to Commodore and now past Commodore Mark Pyle. You did a magnificent job of steering the club through the Covid-19 pandemic and your leadership ability reflects upon the improvements we have made to the club.

If you haven't noticed, we have a new roof over the entire club and a new seawall to the rear. The BLYC roof has been in need of replacement for a period of time. Thanks to the efforts of Brian Thom, the roof project is complete. The replaced shingles have a 50 year limited guarantee.

The new sheet steel seawall was placed out from our old concrete wall approximately 11 feet. This newly created ground is being discussed as to how we will utilize it. The docks are for small water craft — jet skis, kayaks, small sail boats, canoes etc. There is a launch ramp that allows easy access to the lake.

House & Grounds continues to work on many improvement projects. Just to name a few — rear stairs, lift elevator, front porch floor, how to enclose the porch during the winter, concrete around the pool, new pool bar, replace wood behind pool bar, new entrance gates to our docks, reconstructing the band tent, replacing the tile floor behind club's main bar, replacing the seawall and docks on the East side, West wharf, East wharf, front of club, and how to shore up the Eastport boatyard wall supporting the South side of the yard.

As with any of the club's projects, it takes many hours of discussion, engineering, all the what if's, getting bids, appropriating monies, scheduling, prioritizing, changing priorities as the year progresses and so on.

We are planning on doing a fall clean-up day. The date is Sunday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, 9:00 am to Noon. There is plenty to do, our cleaning utensils fit all sizes of hands, all items needed to complete the job are provided. Yes, masks will be required and social distancing as best we can.

## FINANCE COMMITTEE

We are happy to report that in spite of the current pandemic conditions, the Club finished the fiscal year —August 31, 2020 — in a strong financial condition. We have a solid cash position moving into the new fiscal year with significant dollars earmarked for capital projects in the near term. Commodore Ames identified the long list of projects that lie before us and having the resources to be able to prioritize those projects is critical.

You will note that our reported debt level increased \$147,000 during the fiscal year end August 31<sup>st</sup>. The \$147,000 of low interest debt with a term of twenty years was incurred to finance the \$197,000 in Area 800 docks with the \$50,000 difference being donated to the Club in 2020.

We assert that it is probable the \$99,800 borrowed under the Paycheck Protection Program ("PPP") will be forgiven when we are given the go ahead by the bank to process the paperwork. Our financial statements at year end reflect that assertion. We were able to put the PPP cash to good work during the outset of the Covid shutdown allowing us to manage our cash position as dues rolled in.

We have started the budget process for the 2020-2021 fiscal year and hope to be able to advise the Board and provide a clearer direction on membership dues and initiation fees going forward. Our Constitution and By-Laws establish that the Board may enact increases in October and communicate on or before those changes billed in January.
