When I became Race & Regatta Governor, a member asked if we could put colorful numbers at the top of the sail so the spectators could tell the difference between the boats. Each sailboat has a vin number on its hull and a sail number on its sail. These numbers identify the boat and sail and the year it was built.

In scoring and officiating sail racing, all boats are identified by their sail numbers and that is what is called out as they approach the starting line, round the marks, and as they cross the finish line. In the scoring software, the sail number is the first identifying information, not the boat name or the captain. This summer we have provided racing forms from Regatta Network at each table on the porch to help you enjoy the racing. As you can see, *it's all about the sail numbers!*

LOOKING AFT

- P/C Steve Harris, BLYC Historian

Carmen Ohio, Columbus City Water, and the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club...

I'm sure that some of you have heard this story before — it is one of my "go to" articles for this time of year. As we approach the football season and, remembering my friend John, it seems fitting to tell it again this fall.

Charles "Brownie" Cornell was the Commodore of BLYC in 1924. He is one of only four of BLYC's Commodores for whom I haven't found a good photograph — which is odd. Not odd that a photograph may not exist for someone who was Commodore a century ago, but definitely odd as "Brownie" wasn't just *any* member of the Club.

He was apparently a very active member, very involved in the central Ohio community, and particularly quite the character too. The August 10, 1921 issue of *Motorboat*, reported on the "new" feature of powerboat racing at the annual I-LYA Regatta at Put-in-Bay. Included in said article was the following, "A comical feature was added to the sailing program by Brownie Cornell

of the Buckeye Lake Y.C. The first boat finishing in the ladies' cat boat class was that of Cornell, who had 'dolloed up' as a woman." I guess there's a long tradition of BLYC members, shall we say "interesting," behavior at Put-in-Bay.

OK, so not having a picture of a cross-dressing sailor might not be odd, but while obviously quite a character, Brownie was much more. Commodore Cornell was one of the chief engineers on both the O'Shaunessey and Hoover Dams — providing water for the City of Columbus. There is a small, relatively unknown, park dedicated to him on the east side of the Hoover Reservoir. The plaque designating the park reads,

CORNELL PARK

Dedicated in Honor of
C.B. "Brownie" Cornell
1880 – 1961

Who devoted his life to the development and construction of water supply facilities. His foresight and outstanding abilities in his chosen field are everywhere evident in the Columbus Water System.

Pretty impressive! Our friends at Hoover Sailing and Leatherlips Yacht Clubs owe, in part, the existence of the waters they sail on to a Past Commodore of BLYC.

Oh... and what does Carmen Ohio have to do with all of this? Several

years back, at the BLYC Tailgate Parties, P/C John Geiger would emcee a trivia "contest" for us during halftime. One week, he asked the question, "Who wrote Carmen Ohio?" At the time, I felt like I should know the answer, but I just couldn't come up with it. I was certain that I'd read it somewhere before. As it turns out, I read it in the BLYC Log! In Commodore Limes' "Did You Know..." article in March, 1982 *Log*, he mentioned Commodore Cornell and his works as an architect and engineer. He went on to elaborate that "*It was Commodore Cornell's brother Fred who wrote the words of Carmen Ohio, OSU's Alma Mater... The year was 1902, four years before the founding of BLYC.*"

Both Brownie & Fred were varsity athletes at Ohio State. And, as you may already know, it was on the train back from the state up north after a bitter 86-0 defeat that Fred Cornell wrote the lyrics on the back of an envelope. I'm not sure if Fred Cornell was ever a member of BLYC. I'll have to do some more research and see if I can find him in any old directories from that era. Either way, I think he and his Commodore brother would be pleased with the OSU spirit, and the "firm friendship," shown by our BLYC members today. **Go Bucks!**
