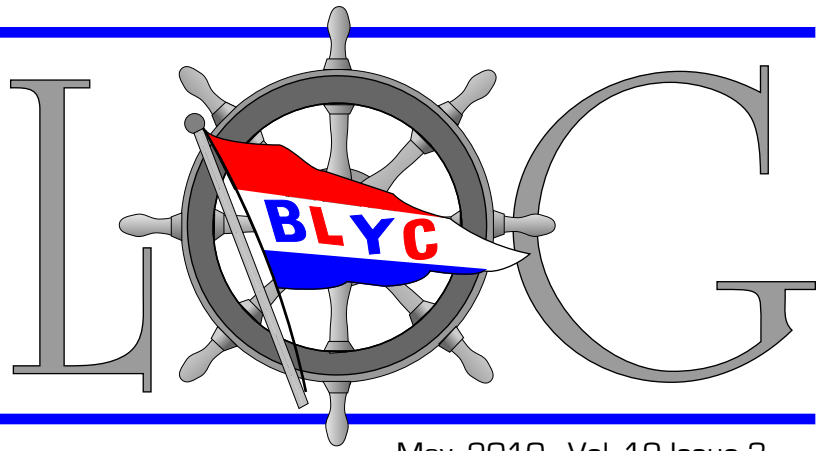

At the April meeting of the Board of Governors, the engineering report was reviewed and a seawall plan was approved. We now move on to the design and bid phase, with construction to start in the fall. The project is right on schedule. The seawall committee under the direction of Governor Myers is working with engineering and bidding; the Board of Trustees is exploring the various modes of financing; and the Board of Governors is developing a plan to retire the incurred debt over time.

THE NEW BAR STOOLS ARE HERE!!!!

They reassured me on Friday, April 9th, that they were slated for immediate shipment to us after they were upholstered. Since this article was submitted April 15th I hope the above statement is true.

These stools have been a really frustrating experience. First I was told they were in stock. About a week later I received a call that there were no mahogany stools in stock and they would have to be ordered from the manufacturer in Europe. Then the order was mishandled at the manufacturer and more time was lost. Finally, I was told they would ship in March with an April delivery to BLYC. The shipment from Europe was made March 4th on a cargo ship which takes approximately 4 weeks (including all stops between there and here). I guess I shouldn't have been surprised; because, this is very similar to the dining room chairs experience.
