

Thanks to the help of Chuck Fadley, Mike Smith, Rose McEntire, Greg McEntire, Bill Collinson, & Mark Severance, the old boards for the west pier walkway have been replaced. We used 102 2x8x14 boards. Each board was cut in half making the actual boards placed to make the walkway all new again 204. Thank you all again.

If you haven't noticed, thanks to Governor Barb Hein, we have two new, very large, flags flying on our flag pole. The American and State of Ohio. I feel all members will agree that they are beautiful to see.

We are in the final stages of making our club access mainly for our members. Quotes for gates, locks, blacktop, key entry etc. are in and being reviewed. When this project is completed, each member will use a, yet to be decided, device to enter the club. Be it a keyfob, pass card, punch pad or whatever, entry to the club and to our docks will be by our members and their guests — not the general public.

We are starting the next step of protecting our island from erosion, Phase II B. The east seawall, docks and overhead cover will be removed starting in October. This project started in 2017 with Phase I, replacement of the seawall by the pool. We began Phase II A, the rear seawall and jet ski/kayak/small sailing craft docks, in 2020 with completion in time for the 2021 boating season. By doing the seawall in phases we have been able to complete other much needed projects right along with each phase.

From time to time, our members need to be informed of what do the governors spend club money on. A small recap starting December of 2020 to July 2021, we have replaced the bar area floor from the floor joists to the tile you walk on, a stove, a prep table, chairs, dish washer, ice machine, porch floor, front of club siding, removed brick flower planter, rear seawall and many small fixes to name a few.

As Vice Commodore, I am in charge of elections for this year. I am taking advantage of this newsletter to encourage all that have a desire to work hard, not get paid, give up the second Thursday of each month, spend money on a uniform, like decision making, want to be involved in shaping the future of this club to consider running. See a governor, get a packet, follow the instructions, run for office, be a governor.

As House & Grounds governor it is my responsibility to, as best as possible, ensure the safety of all members while on club property. Please be alert to where your children are at all times. We are an island which raises the potential of falling into the lake. Secure your boat properly; help those entering and leaving your boat; use hand rails while traversing club steps; NO running around the pool; jump, walk, do a cannon ball while entering the pool but NO diving head first into the pool and NO glass in pool area. If any member or their guest should be injured on club property, please complete an accident form. Forms are kept in the office, just ask any board member or bar tender for a copy.

I had mentioned this next event on several occasions in the past and would like to take this opportunity to speak about it one more time. On Saturday, August 7th, Buckeye Lake Yacht Club will host the Inaugural Cardboard Boat Race Regatta. This event is open to all members of the club and their families as well as to First Responders representing the various townships and villages around the lake. In addition, we are also opening the competition to any teachers in school systems around the lake.

If you visit the yacht club, you will note signage by the Grill Tent advertising the event. Next to the signage there is a

cardboard boat built by Dave Paligo and myself.



This boat was built from cardboard, glue and high

speed duct tape. Please feel free to incorporate these ideas into the construction of your vessel. If you go on line to the BLYC web page, you will see all the information necessary to register your boat for the event.
