not take a breather. If you haven't noticed, there are "candy-cane" like poles at the club entrance and a new exit. Our security entrance gates have been installed. You will be, or have been, given two pass cards along with instructions on their use and what to do when you have guests or lost your pass,

The east dock project is moving along as weather permits. Unless "Murphy's Law" comes into play this project is on targe for completion by 2022 boating season.

We have been given the opportunity to host the 2022, Jet 14, National Championship regatta. During the week July 25, you will want to come to the club to observe this event. Sailors from across the nation will be competing on for our club!

Our own Race and Regatta Governor, Andrea Taylor, is in full go-ahead mode with boating events including has brought the club back to the good "ole" days of BLYC sailing — the, now annual, cardboard boat races, etc. The inaugural start last year of this event has many members wishing they had built a boat. Now is the time to start gathering your cardboard, tape, glue, and begin your journey into the design and construction of your vessel. One item sometimes overlooked is safety of our racing boaters. A committee is in the process of developing safety standards.

The club has entered into a contract with a company who offers a POS, point of sale, system known as JONAS. This system will enhance the ability of our waiting staff to communicate from your table to our kitchen. It will enable our office staff to more accurately keep track of billing, cost of goods sold & purchased, accounting practices, and other needed information.

We have decided to remove ourselves from the house and garage rental business. The single-story house will be repurposed into our maintenance garage. It will provide much needed storage space and be a start into having our maintenance staff out of the club basement. The garages are in need of costly repair. The decision to remove them is the best option. This will happen after June.

The board constantly keeps an eye on what can we do to improve the delivery of fine food to our members. One part is the equipment needed to prepare or keep our food and beverage. The grill, similar to the one we all have for our home cook-outs, was replaced. A new cooler was added behind the bar.

When I was first elected to the Board of Governors, I was placed in charge of sealing the island from Buckeye Lake water. It started with a new seawall by the pool, Phase I. Extending the seawall to the rear of the club, Phase IIA, stretching the seawall to the East, Phase IIB, and now planning to come "full circle". This final phase, Phase III, encompasses the whole front of the club. The final seawall installation will connect and fill the gap between the east seawall and the pool seawall. There is a lot of logistic considerations with this phase...Removal of existing concrete and steel, what is the best way to reconstruct the new seawall? etc. We are using IBI Engineering to assist us in making decisions. We will keep our current foot print but have a new design to make better use of the available space. Our club has over 600 members. On one hand this is awesome, it demonstrates when things are run well it pays. On the other hand, it becomes a difficult task to accommodate all that want to attend certain functions. As of now, new membership is based on one leaves one is asked to become a member. If you are waiting to become a member please be patient. We want you! In closing, I had the privilege of attending the Buckeye Lake Chamber of Commerce Christmas get together. They had a fun filled event. This is one example of what the club can offer you as a member. If you need a venue for your special event the BLYC is your place. Talk to GM Rodney for arrangements.

Waiting List: 52 Inquiries including 2 reinstatements. 2 requested to stay on list until March. 12 have completed all requirements and are ready for membership when the Governors open it again in 2022.

Sponsor Letters: In May 2021, when they instituted the BLYC membership waiting list, the Board of Governors reinstated the by-laws requirement of two sponsor letters accompanying all applications for membership. The applicant is not on the waiting list until the second letter is received. All online applications and sponsor letters are time stamped by the date they are submitted. Please help your friends by emailing their sponsor letters in a timely manner.

2022 Waiting List Fees: The Board of Governors passed the following proposal regardinginitiation fees and Active Membership fees for the 2022 applicants: All applicants on the membership waiting list who have completed an online application and have 2 sponsor letters on file by October 31, 2021 will be accepted at the 2021 initiation and membership fee structure. All applicants on the waiting list completing requirements from November 1, 2021, will be subject to 2022 initiation and membership fees.

Non-Resident Members: The Board of Governors requested that the membership committee review Non-Resident memberships In doing so, the committee found several Non-Resident members are now located within 75 miles of the Club. The Board of Governors will send these members a letter offering them the opportunity to transfer their membership to active status for 2022. The committee also found that the 2005 Board of Governors also addressed this issue: "The term non-resident is not used in the same context as when referring to tax status in Florida or some other warm weather destination. Several of our members spend the winter months in Florida but return to the Buckeye Lake area for the summer. They are not considered non-resident members due to their stay of more than 8 weeks in the local area." (Log: February/March 2005)

The proposal for changes to the Non-Resident By-Laws is published in this Log for review.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CLUB BY-LAWS

The Board of Governors is currently considering changes to Article I. Section 6(a). Of the By-Laws regarding NON-RESIDENT MEMBERS.

As required by Article X of the Constitution, the changes are being published in the December issue of the Log. The Board of Governors would appreciate all feedback and suggestions from the membership.

CURRENT BY-LAWS

By-Law Article 1. Section 6 (a). NON-RESIDENT MEMBERS are only persons residing outside a radius of seventy-five miles from the Club premises and not temporarily residing within the aforesaid radius for more than eight weeks during the fiscal year, each of whom must be at least twenty-one years of age: and each is entitled to the same privileges as those of an Active Member excepting Electoral Privileges.

PROPOSED BY-LAWS CHANGE

January 1, 2022-Non-Resident Members Change the following section:

Article I. Section 6 (a). NON-RESIDENT MEMBERS are only persons residing outside a radius of seventy-five mile from the Club premises and not temporarily residing within the aforesaid radius during the fiscal year, each of whom must be at least twenty-one years of age; and each is entitled to the same privileges as those of an Active Member excepting Electoral Privileges.

NEW RESERVATION POLICY

In the past we have had members make a reservation and not show up, or not everyone in the party be present. The cost of food, beverage, and labor has continuously increased 20%. When you make a reservation, we purchase food, beverages, and increase the number of employees to accommodate all reservations.

Therefore, the Board of Governors has decided to implement a policy governing "No Shows." Beginning February 1st, 2022, a member making a reservation will have until 3:00 p.m. on the date of the reservation to cancel. Between now and February 15th, 2022, detailed information will be sent to all members.

When you are making a reservation, you must state how many people will be in your party. When canceling your reservation, it must be done by the member who made the reservation. Cancelling the reservation must be done by 3:00 p.m. on the date of the reservation. Canceling by 3:00 p.m. affords the opportunity for other members to make reservations. You may cancel the entire reservation or reduce or add the number of people in your party. You may cancel with online reservations or call the club at (740) 929-9941 to cancel.

Failing to cancel your reservation by 3:00 p.m. prior to or on the date of the reservation, the member who made the reservation will be member charged \$25.00 per person who did not show up.


