After working with ODNR, we have come to a resolution on expansion of our club to the south. They have granted us permission to extend our island twenty-five feet straight out. We have signed a lease agreement for all ODNR property we use. The lease agreement is for twenty-five years with an option for twenty-five more. Thank you, ONDR!!

The wall behind the pool bar will be repaired prior to our opening the pool. Anyone interested in assisting please let Governor Collinson, House and Grounds, know. The pool bar is in need of replacement. We are considering options and hopefully can have it in our budget for completion by opening day.

Other events are planned during the summer so in closing, I ask that you take time to view the communication avenues the club offers. 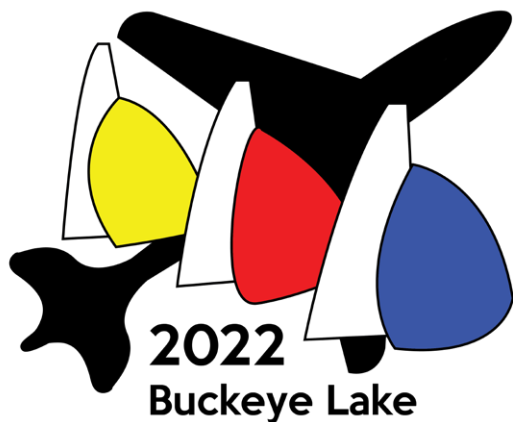

HOUSE & GROUNDS

As I write this article, we will be moving our clocks forward bringing on daylight savings time and the heralding of spring.

Progress continues with the seawall work on the east side of the island and we are currently installing the backfill as well as the electrical conduit that will provide electricity to the new docks.

We have installed our new gates on the bridge as well as on the docks at Area 8 and Eastport. These gates will employ a keypad to allow entrance. The gates at the bridge will also have the option of using your pass card which is the same pass card that you will be using to enter the parking lot. Just a reminder, two pass cards will be mailed to all members prior to activation. The gates on the Area 8 Dock and Eastport Dock will require that you punch in the code upon leaving the dock to open the door. This is to prevent the public from using those docks.

As I Indicated in my last article, the flagpole on the west side of the island incurred catastrophic damage in the ice storm and has since been removed. We have installed the American Flag, the Ohio State Flag and the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club flag on the east flagpole and it is our intent to illuminate these flags at night.



The three large silver maples in front of the white house in our parking lot have been removed. This was necessary in that they were long past their prime and created



a hazard.

The ten-bay garage is set for demolition during the second week of May. In preparation for that, we will be proceeding with electrical work installing an outdoor breaker box that will allow us to remove the power connection from the garage to a new box.

We have scheduled the Spring Work Day for Sunday, April 24. The starting time will be 8:00 a.m. and coffee & donuts will be provided as well as pizza & refreshments for lunch. The three main projects House and Grounds needs completed that day are the removal of insulation and various items in the basement behind the outdoor bar wall in preparation for replacement of that wall. The second is to bring up from the basement and wipe down the pool furniture. The third is a clean

up project at the boat storage yard in preparation for installation of a security fence.

In addition to these three items, we hope to have enough volunteers to clean windows, wipe down woodwork, take down all the burgee flags in the bar area, clean them, and reinstall. If anyone else has suggestions as to what we should cover that day, please feel free to email me at williamxcollinson@gmail.com.



Finally, I am putting out a call for volunteers to assist us with the rebuilding of the outside bar wall. If the weather is good, this project should take approximately one week and will make a huge difference in the integrity and appearance of that area. The start date for this project is Monday April 25th.

Please check your calendar for availability to participate in our clean up day and I hope to see you all then.

Changing a Boat's Name...

It's happened to us all — you found the perfect boat. She has everything you want in a vessel and the price is right — but her name is just not right for you! So, what do you do? Does changing the name of a boat bring bad luck? Is there a way of re-naming a boat safely so that the gods are placated?

Actually, it's not so much being superstitious as being v-e-r-y careful. It's an essential part of good seamanship. It's well known that renaming a boat can bring bad luck but did you know that, with a little preparation, and if done in the right way, you CAN re-name your boat without invoking the wrath of the gods?

To change the name of a vessel without consulting Poseidon is to invoke his wrath. So, in order to change a boat's name, a traditional ceremony is used to appease the gods of the seas.

What is the ritual for renaming a boat? A ceremony should consist of five parts: an invocation, an expression of gratitude, a supplication, a re-naming and (of course) a libation.

How you conduct the ceremony depends entirely on you. We used a shortened version of Vigor's inter-denominational denaming and renaming ceremonies.
