#### It's Summer!

Memorial Day weekend saw the opening of our pool and the beginning of another great summer at the BLYC.

While planning that well deserved summer vacation, don't forget to look at the BLYC calendar of events. Sailboat racing, Car Show, Boat Show, Junior Sailing events, fantastic entertainment, Auxiliary Fundraiser and dancing, Cardboard Boat Race, Jet-14 National Championships right here on Buckeye Lake hosted by your BLYC and much more...

At the writing of this article, the entrance and exit gate project is in trial mode. We are trying everything we can think of that would cause a member, guest, staff, emergency services, delivery company, etc. to not be able to enter when the gate is closed. When you receive your pass cards you will also receive instructions/

information on all aspects of entry to the club.

The east side seawall and dock project is now complete. This was the third phase of a four-phase seawall/dock restoration journey. When you now enter the Club, you will pass the best docks on the lake. This particular phase provides premier docks, wide space slips, electric for lifts, direct island access and WHAT A VIEW OF THE LAKE!!

Our next and final phase of island preservation is the front basin. I have stated in previous articles that ODNR has leased us an additional twenty-five feet of club frontage. This is a huge increase of usable space. Our engineering firm, IBI Engineering, will have final plans soon. In the meantime, when visiting the club, take a few moments and look at the bar TV kiosk. It shows renderings of what the front will be formed into.

When you make a reservation for dining or an event you are guaranteed a table for the number of persons you made the reservation for. This reservation sets in motion how many servers, bussers, kitchen staff, bartenders, etc. we will use for that time. It tells our chef, Rodney, how much food to purchase and prepare. It tells our bar staff what special drinks might be appropriate. We consider each event or dining experience to be special. The Club expectation is that each member and guest have the best experience possible each time they enter the BLYC. When you make a reservation and do not show up it costs the Club, staff, and a member who could not get a table. This is the club policy on no cancel, no show:

#### COMMODORE

- If you can't make a reservation, call the club prior to 5:00 pm the day of the reservation. Member only has to call if no one in the group can make the reservation.
- If only one (1) person of the reservation group can make the reservation, that is enough to satisfy the reservation.

Failure for either of these to occur, no one calls or shows up, will cause the member who made the reservation to pay \$25.00 per the number of persons the reservation was made for. It will be added to the member's charge. This fee breaks down to: \$5 for server, \$3 for bar tender, \$2 for busser and \$15 for BLYC (kitchen staff and food purchase/preparation.)

The BLYC Boards of Governors and Trustees are exploring the finance options for the final phase of the seawall project, the front basin. We have narrowed financing down to six options: bank financing; assessment, increase fees; member donations without possibility of tax deduction; donation with possibility of tax deduction, and bonds sold only to members.

Soon, you will see our dining staff with laptops when they come to your table. This is part of our new ordering, accounting, and information system known as JONAS.

The BLYC has actively pursued forming a club charitable organization. Great news was just received from the IRS. Thanks to the finance committee and BLYC member, Attorney Mark Watson, we now have a stand-alone, IRS determined public charity under Section 501(c)3. It is known as the Watkins Island Foundation, Inc. (WIF). The finance committee is working on the rules that will govern donations to the WIF.

Hope to see you all out at the club this summer and invite you to come out on Sundays to enjoy the sail boat races.



#### FINANCE COMMITTEE

We have completed eight months of our fiscal year and while the cost of goods and labor have continued to increase, the good news is the Club is still within the budget targets we set early in the year. Our House and Grounds team is pushing forward to complete the capital improvement projects planned and started in prior years. In addition, the Club has been presented with an opportunity to expand the island while replacing the front and west sea walls. The engineering work is underway and the governmental approval process will follow.

If approved, the expansion of the island and removal and replacement of the sea walls and walkways will require a substantial amount of capital. While we have been closely managing the capital improvement dollars and accumulated a reserve of approximately \$300,000, we will need to raise more funds quickly in the months following project approval. The Finance Committee is investigating and weighing different options and expect to recommend to the board the use multiple means to raise the funds.

The options being considered include; commercial borrowing, special member assessment, capital improvement campaign or fund drive, increasing member dues, issuing unsecured bonds to members and pursuing foundation donations. Recently the Watkins Island Foundation was established as a resource for community charitable endeavors and to preserve and improve the historic island and structures of Watkins Island. As we move forward and get better cost estimates for the improvements ahead, we will be able to provide more clarity on the financing aspects of these necessary and exciting improvements for the Club.

**Membership Numbers:** At the Semi-Annual Meeting the membership reported 592 total members with 561 voting members. This is down from May 2021 of 601 total members with 558 voting members.

#### **Membership Waiting List:**

At the May Board of Governors Meeting, we reviewed Club usage numbers from May 2021 through April 2022. There were four months where we had 1000+ members and guests use the Club. On an average Friday or Saturday night, we have fewer than 20% of our membership in attendance. The Board of Governors voted to open membership to the 30 new applicants and the 3 reinstatements on the waiting list. We will be posting their applications, sponsor letters, and pictures as they send in their fees. The first reading for this group will be at the next Board of Governors meeting in June.


Thank you to all our members who have written sponsor letters for our potential new members.

#### LOOKING AFT

- P/C Steve Harris, BLYC Historian

I was appointed BLYC Historian 10 years ago, in 2012, by Commodore Bob Zeiher, who recently passed away. Bob's family will be having a small Celebration of Life for him at the Club laster this summer.

I am quite fortunate to follow a number of previous Club Historians who have left us a great legacy of stories and photos of the rich 100-yearplus history of our Club. Prior to myself, Commodore Frank Foster, III (1983) had served as our historian for an astonishing 27 years. Among the articles Frank penned over the years for the Log, is this one which I've shared before. As we enter another season at the lake and our sailboat racing program continues to grow, it seems appropriate to share again.

#### **Porch Sitting & Race Watching** ... A Long Tradition

Commodore Frank H. Foster, III March, 1987

Public notice of a meeting to form a club was given in late April, 1906. Through the summer and fall of 1906, the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club was formed. That winter, around January of 1907, a corporation was formed to sell 1,000 shares of stock at \$5.00 each for the purpose of acquiring land and constructing a clubhouse. Abou that same time the incorporators of the building corporation took over a lease on "sunken island" and a half lot on the lake's main shore facing the island. It was a spot of sometimes land with several half grown trees, mostly willows, surrounded by always shallow water and, especially in the spring, frequently flooded completely. They envisioned that it could be raised and enlarged and the waters around it deepened. It offered privacy because it was an island and was located only about 300 yards from the interurban railway. Drawings of a beautiful building were prepared,



and I have a copy of it and published it in an earlier Log. When the bids were opened, the building was too expensive and the club officers decided to confine their efforts to the bare necessities within their limited needs. Bids were requested for a simpler building and a contract was awarded for \$1,811.00. Constrution began in early summer of 1907 and was completed in November.

*In the summer of 1908, a porch was* built across the building's outer end extending somewhat past the easterly and westerly walls.

*In* 1912-1913 the new, present clubhouse was constructed and the old one was modified, later damaged, and ultimately replaced by our current boat houses on the east side of the

This, it appears that this picture must have been taken between 1908 and 1912. The picture looks north-easterly Editor's Note (Musings of an old P/C): or east-northeast down toward our present Eastport facility. Much as we do today, it appears that a group had gathered on the front porch and was watching the racing sailors. Others were pursuing their activities. From the appearance of the flags, the wind seems to have been at the same slow speed we often find now days. As you can see "Sunken Island," now Watkins Island, was raised and a seawall poured around it. The island, in

fact, was considerably more circular and smaller than now. Since the porch was so close to the water they must have been able to hear pleasant sounds of the water slapping against boats, docks, and seawall. Our new deck, adjacent the swimming pool on the west side of the island, may afford us an opportunity for the same pleasant sounds.

From the appearance of the shadows it must have been around mid-day, probably a Sunday. Our lawn is certainly in much better shape now that it was then.

While the building is a neat, old building, I certainly am glad they later acquired a stronger financial position and built the current clubhouse. They sure had the right idea for a good way to spend a Sunday afternoon.

Hope to see you on the porch this summer!
