final implementation of our plan and in keeping with our policy of transparency, there will be an informational meeting Sunday August 21, 1:00 to 3:00 pm. This is for members and significant other only. It is not a special meeting and there will be no voting. The Board of Governors will provide answers on how project construction will move forward, how we plan to pay for this, suggested remedies for those who will not be able to use their boat slips and the projected look when completed. All questions are welcomed and an answer given based on information at the time of the meeting.

BLYC Cardboard Boat races were a huge success. Thank you Governor Taylor. It's amazing the ingenuity used to build cardboard boats. Although the race course is short, making a boat out of "paper" to float long enough to make it around the course is in itself a feat of engineering. The BLYC entry gate system is now in service. You will need to have your entry card available to enter the parking lot gate and to enter the bridge gate. When leaving, as you approach the bridge gate, look to your left, on the guard rail is a button. Push the button and hold for two seconds, you will hear a beep, then open the gate. The keypad attached to the bridge gate will NOT let you in or out. If you have forgot your entry card, get close to the keypad, push A, then push Call, you will hear a phone ring. Someone inside club will answer, they will ask for your name and club number. Once verified, they will open the gate. If you drove to the club you will have to repeat the same procedure at the bridge gate. If you have guests, call the club for a four number gate entry code. This code is only good for your guests and will be erased when their visit is over. There is a learning curve, mistakes will happen, which, when we become aware, will be corrected to better your experience. If you haven't picked up your cards please do so. Just ask any of the club staff to assist in getting your card, they will. If your cards do not work call the office, 740-929-9941, Deana will assist in solving your card problems. If you lost a card or need additional cards you must get approval from the Board of Governors prior to replacing or adding. The cost is \$100 per card.

The annual membership meeting of the BLYC is Sunday, September 18. The voting for members to the Board of Governor's starts at 09:00 until 1:00 pm. You need to vote! While preparing to select who to vote for, you can enjoy a selection of food offered by the candidates. The actual meeting will start promptly at 14:00 (2:00 pm). The new Commodore and the new Board will take office during this meeting. Plan to attend.

We have received several complaints about members bringing the same guests multiple times. Please be respectful to your fellow members and be courteous when it comes to bringing a guest. We will monitor this and speak to any member who violates this policy. This also includes the pool.

I appreciate all of the comment cards via the website and the hard copies. Please keep filling them out! I look at each and everyone of them. As I have mentioned previously, we can't fix an issue if we are not made aware of it. It may something very small or something big to someone but if we don't know that there is an issue, we can't make it better.
