BLYC Perpetual Trophies... BLYC Long Distance Races

As we have since the first official gathering of the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club — Memorial Day, 1906 — BLYC holds three "distance races" each season - Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day. I recall years back, while we were holding an I-LYA Traveler Series Junior Regatta at the Club, we had a poster up encouraging people to register for the upcoming "Long Distance Race." A sailing friend from Port Clinton Yacht Club inquired of me, "What do you do? Sail the length of the lake 10 times?" The races are not distance races in the normal sense. Most true distance races cover long expanses of open water — Chicago to Mackinac, Newport to Bermuda, or the Mills Trophy Race from Toledo to Put-in-Bay, for example. While the idea of a "distance" race on Buckeye Lake may seem odd, we work with what we have. Each of these races has a perpetual trophy awarded to the winner, each bearing the name of a BLYC Commodore.

Doing some research, I discovered that all three of these trophies were inaugurated the same year, 1969. Digging deeper, I came across a *Log* article from our Commodore that year, Edward C. Metzger, in which he announced his gift of a new trophy for the Memorial Day race, and encouraged others to consider doing the same.

"I was most pleased to bestow Skipper Jim Dressel the Commodore Metzger Trophy on Memorial Day. This is the first recipient of this newly deeded trophy for the Long Distance Race -Memorial Day, any Class, Handicap. Congratulations, Jim... We are asking anyone who desires to offer a trophy to the Club to supply a properly detailed Deed supporting the purpose, duration, description of qualifications to receive the award, etc. This could be a problem, and we want a permanent record of each Trophy and the Deed. The Club must approve any gift..."

So, there are two basic ways that trophies are named — they are either named *for* someone (as in the "Gussie" and the Fisher) or they are named *by* someone (as in the Heber and these long distance race trophies.) Unfortunately, I've never seen, nor have I come across the deeds of gift for these trophies. I hope we've been awarding them properly. I've collected a bit of information about the Commodores who generously provided these trophies.

Memorial Day Distance Race Commodore Edward C. Metzger (1969)

Ed Metzger was our Commodore in 1969. He was elected to the Board in 1965 and served as Secretary/Treasurer his first two years, prior to being elected Rear Commodore. He again served as Secretary/Tresurer in 1974 & 1976, following his time as Commodore, when the Club Constitution was changed to allow that position to be filled by a nonmember of the Board. He was the 1968 recipient of the Heber Yachtsman Merit Trophy. He owned and operated an insurance agency in Columbus.

Perusing old issues of the Log, Commodore Metzgar's year was very focused on sailing and family activities at the Club — "Family Sundays," Singa-Longs, and parties specifically for the juniors. His year was probably most known, however, for liquor... Two days prior to the 1968 Annual Meeting, the Club was cited for the sale of liquor without a license. Apparently, BLYC's permit it had held since the 1930's only allowed for the sale of beer, not "spiritous liquors." Under Metzger's leadership, the D1 permit was cancelled and the Club applied for, and received, a D4 "Private Club" permit. It was not without consequence, however. The permit specifically forbade gambling and games of chance, along with carrying in of alcohol from off-premises (much as our current permit does). It also restricted sales to Club members only.

Labor Day Distance Race Commodore Dwight Haggard (1960) and

Independence Day Distance Race Comodore Earl O. Williams (1961)

Few records remain from the time of Commodore Williams and Haggard

on the Board, but those that do are significant – the purchase of Watkins Island. For much of the history of our lake, the State of Ohio controlled all of the land adjacent to the dam and most, if not all, of the islands including Watkins Island. These lands were then leased to individuals by the state. In November of 1957, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources determined these lands to be "no longer needed for public recreation ... or other projects of a public nature" and sold them to the leaseholders. The Club had the land appraised and determined an approximate value of \$5,000 for the island and the Club had sufficient funds earmarked in savings for said purchase. To their surprise however, when the state presented their offer to BLYC, it included nearly 30% more land – much of it underwater - at a total cost of over \$11,000! Commodore Haggard and his board focused on raising the necessary funds and in August of 1960, the Board of Trustees approved the expenditure of \$11,608.14 for the purchase of the island.

The following spring, when it came time to write the check, the Club had less than \$4,000 of cash available. However, as noted in a May 2nd letter to all members announcing the date of the semi-annual meeting, there were over \$7,000 of unpaid dues still outstanding. A check was cut to the State that same day and presumably enough of the unpaid dues were collected as the check apparently cleared and ownership of Watkins Island was transferred to BLYC on May 22, 1961. Despite the obvious financial hardship this presented the Club, Commodore Williams' year ended with over \$5,000 in available cash and within a few years, BLYC was back on solid financial ground.

Both Williams and Haggard remained active in BLYC for many years thereafter and are remembered through our Independence Day and Labor Day Distance Race Trophies.

Commodore Jim Dressel (1981)

It is of significant note that the inaugural recipient of all three of these trophies in 1969 was Jim Dressel — championship sailor, Junior Training Governor at the time, and our 1981 Commodore.
