Hello Members! This is Executive Chef Josh providing you with an update regarding recent and forthcoming menu changes designed to enhance your overall restaurant experience! There is a new fall look to the menu that was heavily influenced by your menu feedback and suggestions (THANK YOU!). We are now offering entrée style meals with your steak, chicken, and salmon dishes that include two sides of your choice. You will also notice most of our weekly features now include sides. We have switched from a smaller

burger into a much larger 1/3-pound black angus burger with a brioche bun. This makes a great combination with our brand new 3/8" straight cut french fry.

You will notice that there are two new chicken dishes on the fall menu as well. 

Boating Season ends on November 1st ODNR regulations say we need to have our boats out of the water at that time. BLYC will have the water on and the dumpster and port-a-pot available until November 15th for those who are putting away their boats. Please park your boats in the Eastport boatyard in the spots assigned to you on your lease agreement.

Membership Privileges: One of the privileges of BLYC membership is out of season storage at the Eastport boatyard. Storage can be on a trailer or on blocks from now until October 31st, 2026. Yes, during boating season, the trailer can be parked in your space. The Eastport boatyard is a secure facility. Contact docksandrentals@buckeyelakeyc.com to reserve your storage space at below market price.

Another membership amenity is the leasing of dock space for 2026 boating season. If you are a current dock holder,

now is the time to let us know that you want to continue with your dock and/or exchange docks. If you would like a dock, please complete the Dock Application on the BLYC website. Invoicing for docks is in February. We need a copy of your boat insurance and your boat registration on file for 2026 for Eastport boatyard storage and for your 2026 dock. You can email them to docksandrentals@buckeyelakeyc.com.

There is a waiting list for each docking area (on-island, area 8, and Eastport) and docks are given according to the rules in the Constitution and By-Laws. (By-Laws Article VII and Article XI) Please note all requests must be submitted by online application to the Governor of Docks and Rentals. If you had a dock in 2025 and are not planning to lease a dock in 2026 please email docksandrentals@buckeyelakyc.com.

Bird Control: We have installed solar squawk boxes at Area 8 and Eastport docks. All the boxes will be used until the seagulls move on from Buckeye Lake. Even though the boats are no

longer in the docks, we do not want the gulls to roost on our docks.

To keep our docks and boatyard shipshape, we have a Docks Committee consisting of P/C Charles Campbell, P/C Jeff Hamilton, Scott Evans, Tom Reynolds, Mike Smith, Mike Fornataro, Matt Fennen, and David Olney to review all docks and the boatyard. Goals for the year include:

- Boatyard cleanup including cleaning the fence line and adjusting the fence on the east side.
- Keeping the seagulls off our dock areas.
- Power washing all docks as bird blasts occur.
- Identifying and repairing docks as needed.
- Having all boater registration and insurance declaration page on file for all dock rentals.

Show Them the Ropes

Leadership changes at the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club are different than anything I've ever experienced. Instead of running for a specific position, those who desire to join the governing board submit their names into the running for the office of Governor. Once the governors are chosen by the general membership, the Commodore assigns to the governors, according to his own pleasure, knowledge, and input from others, the various roles the governors will fill during his or her tenure.

It's not unusual for a governor to be assigned a position for which he or she feels unqualified. This means that the person or persons who have previously filled that role will need to help the novice become familiar with all the various responsibilities to which s/he has been charged. They will need to show the newbie the ropes.

The roots of the idiom "show them the ropes" are probably very familiar. Almost all operations on a sailing vessel involve ropes - halyards, shrouds, sheets, warps, reefs, lifts, outhauls, downhauls — and even though (especially on older ships) these were all actual ropes made from hemp or whatever, none of them were called "ropes." And for good reason. Imagine, in a crisis, the captain giving orders to "Winch that rope 'till she's taut! No not *THAT* rope... that one!!" A specific function requires a specific name. An effective crew member must learn the ropes.

A new governor taking on a new role requires a boatload of humility. A cynical person might think that aspiring leaders desire to govern because they are arrogant or prideful. Not so. There's a proverb that asserts "Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall" (Proverbs 16:18), ESV). A person who desires a leadership position out of selfish motives will eventually be humiliated. Jesus admonished His disciples "Whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be your slave" (Matthew 20:26, ESV). Let's honor our leaders and especially support those who are learning the ropes around their new positions for the first time.

What was happening at BLYC 50 Years Ago?...

50 years ago, our Commodore was Robert Preston. Preston was Assistant Adjutant General of the Ohio Air National Guard and was responsible for starting the annual fly-overs at Buckeye Lake that we enjoyed for many years on the 4th of July. By all accounts, celebrating the 70th anniversary of the founding of our club and the 200th anniversary of the founding of our nation, 1976 was a good year for BLYC.

A "Founder's Day Party" was held on April $24^{\rm th}$ — 70 years to the day after the first organizational meeting held at Leachmen's Chop House in Columbus. Hors d'oeuvres were provided by the Past Commodores' ladies, cocktails flowed freely, followed by dinner and dancing — sounds a lot like our parties of today.

The Club also hosted quite the weekend celebration for the Bicentennial. It kicked off with a party up and down the towpath followed by a band on the yacht club porch on Saturday the 3rd. Sunday the 4th brought a Champagne Breakfast, the traditional flag raising, boat parade, jet fly-over and, of course, sailboat races. That evening there was a cookout at the club, a "floating cocktail party" hosted by the Venture fleet, and fireworks. Monday was more of the same with another Champagne Breakfast, the long distance race, kids games, and a "Beer & Coke Bust."

Sailing was king at BLYC in the 1970's, and 1976 was no exception. There were five active fleets racing at BLYC that season — Highlanders, Lasers, Lidos, Lightnings, and Ventures. Eleven boats represented BLYC at the I-LYA Regatta — 3 Lidos, 7 Ventures, and a K-boat, Cat's Paw, skippered by P/C Gus Schell. Junior sailing camps were led by head instructor Holly Petersilge (now Holly Hanbaum, still active at BLYC.) Among the "first year sailors" mentioned in the Log that year was a girl named Tracey Hein (now Davis, also still an active member.) BLYC sailors enjoyed great successes, both on and off Buckeye Lake. In particular, our juniors did very well. BLYC was represented in the US triplehanded quarterfinals at Put-in-Bay by the team of Willie Petersilge, Dan Roshon, and Tom Hudgins who competed their way to a 3rd place finish. We were represented by Dan Dressel and Steve Beeson in the Doublehanded and Lonn Moyer in the Singlehanded class — both regattas being held in Port Clinton. Lonn won the quarterfinals, won the semifinals at Portage Lake in Michigan, and finished a strong 8th in the finals in Miami.

Joining BLYC in 1976 and celebrating 50 years of membership this year are Chet Hauck, P/C Frank Foster, III (1983), P/C George Conrad(1990), and our Parliamentarian, Tom Campbell. As with any year, however, there was sadness too. Commodore Kyle W. Armstrong who joined BLYC in 1920, served as Commodore in 1949, received the Heber Award in 1954 and authored *The Story of Buckeye Lake Yacht Club* to commemorate our 50th Anniversary in 1956, passed away in March, just weeks shy of the Club's 70th birthday.

SAILING FLEETS

I hate this time of year... the morning chill has returned, the leaves are falling, the sporadic rain has returned and all that I can see is the end of the sailing season and a long gray winter stretching out before me.

Looking back on the 2025 Racing/Sailing season, many changes have taken place with this rapidly growing BLYC fleet...

Spring found us holding classes on Sailing Rules, Boat Handling, Safety-At-Sea, as well as Tactics and Strategy. By late April and early May, several PHRF boats were in the water and beginning to practice, trying to remove those winter cobwebs and rust before the season opener.

During the Lambrecht Cup Series, we put 10-12 boats to the start line, crewmembers were honing in on teamwork and boat handling skills, skippers were working on tactics required for the competition and all the teams were looking for that "First Place horn" and being able to fly the coveted checkered Performance Rabbit Flag.

As I write this, I'm reflecting back to our race season. I thought of the countless little bits of knowledge we took for granted every race as we prepared the boat, but what really stands out to me was that after every race, the post-race socializing reflected what crews were doing to improve their teamwork, which then improves the competitiveness of the fleet. After only a few years of fleet building, we continue to see sailors interested in these sailboats, not only for the boat performance, but because they have heard that the BLYC fleet is social, friendly, supportive of new racers, and yet at the same time highly competitive.

We are already looking forward to the 2026 race and sailing season.
